



Residential MARKET REPORT

Boston • Cambridge • Somerville June 2021

BOSTON, CAMBRIDGE, AND SOMERVILLE SHARE A COLLECTIVE POPULATION OF JUST UNDER 1,000,000 PEOPLE ACROSS 40+ NEIGHBORHOODS. IN THIS REPORT, WE PRESENT KEY MARKET STATISTICS AND EXPLORE WHAT THESE FIGURES COULD MEAN TO BUYERS, SELLERS, AND RENTERS.

Overview

How has the market fared at the mid-year point? Of the national housing market, The Washington Post reports, "While home prices are still rising, they're rising at a slower pace than in recent months." In Greater Boston, though, the market is still on a roll. Boston saw 61 single-family homes sold for an average of \$1,178,352; single-family homes in Cambridge sold for approximately \$2,043,652. Somerville condos are steadily climbing towards the million-dollar mark as 68 units sold in June for an average of \$910,918.

Boston

Boston reigns supreme among the three markets with the most single-family and condo units sold. In June, 61 single-family homes sold for an average of \$1,178,352, and 439 condos went for an average of \$914.564. Compared to May, single-family homes saw a rise in average price per square foot, increasing by \$2 to \$544, and condos saw a slight decrease in their average price per square foot from \$809 to \$798. Each property type also saw a significant drop in average days on the market; single families and condos spent about 26 and 29 days, respectively, on the market before being sold to new owners. currently has 52 single-family homes on the market listed at an average of \$1,591,765 and 448 condos priced at for average of \$1,151,674. Buyers hoping to call Boston home should expect to pay upwards of \$900,000 for a property in this area.

Rental rates in the city also continue to climb with sale prices. In June, a two-bedroom apartment in Boston reportedly cost about \$3,163 per month. There are presently over 500 two-bedroom apartments on the market listed for an average asking price of \$2,932. Renters looking for studios and one-bedrooms in neighborhoods closer to the city, like the North or South Ends, or South Boston, could assumingly pay closer to this amount as well.











Cambridge

The Cambridge market saw a healthy month of sales, with over 100 singlefamily homes and condos selling for over \$1,000,000. This month, 23 singlefamily residences sold for an average of \$2,043,652. The condo market in Cambridge saw 79 units sell for an average of \$1,050,089. Buyers looking for handsome investment opportunities in a thriving market should look in this area for their next home. Rental prices held steady from the last month; the average two-bedroom will run renters about \$2,953 per month. Cambridge continues to be a highly desired rental market for students and professionals with convenient public transportation and plenty of modern amenities.

Somerville

The Somerville housing market saw interesting changes over May's reported figures. In June, 12 single-family homes sold for an average of \$920,604. In this same period, there were 68 condo units in Somerville sold for an average of \$910,918. Buyers here could find themselves paying less for their homes than their neighbors in Cambridge while still having access to many of the same amenities. Rental rates in Somerville dropped from last month to \$2,534 per month for a two-bedroom. Renters looking for easy access to the city without paying those higher prices should look here.
