THE FIRST LETTER INDICATES NEIGHBORHOOD CONTEXT.

S = SUBURBAN G = GENERAL URBAN U = URBAN E = URBAN EDGE

C = URBAN CENTER

THE SECOND LETTER INDICATES THE DOMINANT BUILDING FORM AND CHARACTER.

SU = SINGLE UNIT MU = MULTI UNIT

TU = TWO UNIT RO = RESIDENTIAL OFFICE

TH = TOWNHOME RX = RESIDENTIAL MIXED USE

RH = ROW HOME CC = COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR

MS = MAIN STREET MX = MIXED USE

THE THIRD LETTER OR NUMBER INDICATES BUILDING OR LOT SIZE.

AN EXTRA NUMBER OR LETTER AT THE END INDICATES A SPECIAL PURPOSE OR REGULATION THIS IS WHERE YOU WOULD FIND ZONING FOR AN ADU.

EXAMPLES:

U-SU-A THIS IS AN URBAN AREA ALLOWING FOR A SINGLE UNIT WITH A MINIMUM LOT SIZE OF 3000 SF.

G-MU-3 THIS IS A GENERAL NEIGHBORHOOD ZONED FOR MULTI-FAMILY UNITS UP TO 3 STORIES

C-MX-5 THIS IS AN URBAN CENTER ALLOWING COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL BUILDING UP TO 5 STORIES
